NOTICE OF THE 24TH ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

NOTICE is hereby given that the Twenty Fourth (24th) Annual General Meeting ('AGM') of the member(s) of **IndiaMART InterMESH Limited** ('the Company') will be held on **Tuesday**, **June 13, 2023 at 11:00 a.m.** IST through Video Conferencing ('VC') or Other Audio Visual Means ('OAVM'), for which purpose the Registered Office of the Company situated at 1st Floor, 29-Daryaganj, Netaji Subash Marg, New Delhi-110002 shall be deemed as the venue for the Meeting wherein the proceedings of the AGM shall be deemed to have been conducted, to transact the following businesses:

ORDINARY BUSINESS:

To consider and, if thought fit, to pass the following resolutions as an **Ordinary Resolution:**

- To receive, consider and adopt the Audited Standalone & Consolidated Financial Statements of the Company for the financial year ended March 31, 2023, together with the Reports of the Board of Directors and Auditors thereon.
- 2. To declare dividend of ₹ 20/- per equity share for the financial year ended March 31, 2023.
- 3. To appoint a Director in place of Mr. Dhruv Prakash (DIN: 05124958), who retires by rotation and being eligible, offers himself for re-appointment.

SPECIAL BUSINESS:

4. To approve issue of bonus equity shares

To consider and, if thought fit, to pass the following resolution as an **Ordinary Resolution**:

"**RESOLVED THAT** pursuant to the provisions of Section 63 and other applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013, read with relevant rules framed thereunder, SEBI (Issue of Capital and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2018 ("the ICDR Regulations"), SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 ("Listing Regulations") and other applicable regulations issued by the SEBI and the Reserve Bank of India ("RBI") (including any statutory modification(s) or re-enactment thereof from time to time), the relevant provisions of the Articles of Association of the Company subject to such approvals, permissions and sanctions as may be necessary and further subject to such conditions and modifications as may be prescribed or imposed while granting such approvals, permissions and sanctions which may be agreed to by the Board of Directors (hereinafter referred to as "Board", which expression shall be deemed to include a duly authorised Committee of Directors), the consent of the members of the Company be and is hereby accorded to issue bonus equity shares, by capitalising a sum not exceeding ₹ 30,61,45,740/- (comprising of ₹ 16,00,000/- from and out of the Capital Redemption Reserves and balance of ₹ 304,545,740/- from Securities Premium Account of the Company) as per the Audited Financial Statements of the Company for the financial year ended March 31, 2023 for the issue and allotment of 3,06,14,574 bonus equity shares of ₹ 10/- (Rupees Ten) each credited as fully paid-up equity shares to the equity shareholders of the Company, whose names appear in the Register of Members maintained by the Company's Registrars and Transfer Agents / List of Beneficial Owners, as received from the National Securities Depository Limited (NSDL) and Central Depository Services (India) Limited (CDSL), on record date i.e., Wednesday, June 21, 2023 ("Record Date"), in the proportion of 1 (one) new fully paid-up equity share of ₹ 10/- (Rupees Ten) each for every 1(one) existing fully paid-up equity share of ₹ 10/- (Rupees Ten) each as held by them on the record date.

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT the Board be and is hereby authorised, to make appropriate adjustments to the Employee Stock Options/SARs unit (unvested or vested but not exercised) granted to the employees of the Company under Indiamart Employe Stock Benefits Scheme – 2018 ('Scheme') as on record date, pursuant to SEBI (Share Based Employee Benefits and Sweat Equity) Regulations, 2021 and amendments thereto from time to time, (whether vested but not exercised or unvested) be adjusted in accordance with the provisions as contained in the Scheme, for giving effect to the issue of Bonus Shares.

FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Bonus Shares so allotted shall rank pari-passu in all respects with the existing fully paid-up equity shares of the Company and shall always be subject to the terms and conditions contained in the Memorandum and Articles of Association of the Company and carry the same rights as the existing fully paid Equity Shares of the Company.

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RESOLVED FURTHER THAT no letter of allotment shall be issued in respect of the Bonus Shares and the shareholders of the Company who hold shares of the Company in dematerialized form as on record date, the Bonus Shares shall be credited to the respective demat accounts of the shareholders and the shareholders of the Company who hold shares of the Company in physical form as on record date, the share certificate(s) in respect of the bonus equity shares shall be dispatched within such time as prescribed by law and the relevant authorities.

FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the issue and allotment of the proposed bonus shares to the extent that they relate to Members who are Non- Resident Indians (NRIs), Foreign Institutional Investors (FIIs) and other Foreign Investors, shall be subject to the approval, if any, of the Reserve Bank of India under the Foreign Exchange Management Act, 1999 and other applicable rules/regulations/guidelines issued/amended by RBI or any other authority, from time to time, in this regard.

RESOLVED FURTHER THAT the Board be and is hereby authorized to take necessary steps for listing of such shares on the Stock Exchanges where the securities of the Company are listed as per the provisions of the Listing Regulations and other applicable guidelines, rules and regulations.

FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Board be and is hereby authorized to do all such acts, deed and things including delegating powers to employees and/ or officers of the Company, as they may in their absolute discretion deem necessary or expedient in respect of matters and things incidental or related thereto and to settle any question or doubt, to give effect to the aforesaid resolution."

 In view of the relaxation granted by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs ('MCA') vide its General Circular No. 14/2020 dated April 08, 2020, Circular No. 17/2020 dated April 13, 2020, Circular No. 20/2020 dated May 05, 2020, Circular No. 02/2022 dated May 05, 2022 and Circular No. 10/2022 dated December 28, 2022 ('MCA Circulars') and SEBI vide it's circular no. SEBI/HO/ CFD/CMD1/CIR/P/2020/79 dated May 12, 2020, SEBI/HO/ CFD/CMD2/CIR/P/2021/11 dated January 15, 2021, SEBI/ HO/CFD/CMD2/CIR/P/2022/62 dated May 13, 2022 and SEBI/HO/CFD/PoD-2/P/CIR/2023/4 dated January 05, 2023 ('SEBI circular') (MCA Circular and SEBI Circular collectively referred as Circulars) has permitted the holding of the AGMs through VC/OAVM facility and dispensed physical presence of the members at the meeting. In compliance with the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 ('Act'), SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 ('Listing Regulations') and Circulars, the 24th AGM of the Company is being held through VC/OAVM facility. The deemed venue for the AGM shall be the Registered Office of the Company. The detailed procedure for participating through VC/OAVM facility is mentioned in Note No. 21 of the notice. Since the AGM will be held through VC/OAVM, the Route Map is not annexed to this Notice.

- 2. The relevant explanatory statement pursuant to the provisions of Section 102(1) of the Act setting out the material facts and reasons, concerning the business under Item No. 4 of this Notice of AGM is annexed herewith. Further, the relevant details, pursuant to Regulations 36(3) of the Listing Regulations and Secretarial Standards on General Meetings issued by the Institute of Company Secretaries of India ('Secretarial Standard-2'), in respect of Director seeking re-appointment at the AGM are also annexed to this Notice.
- 3. Since the AGM is being convened through VC or OAVM in terms of the Circulars, the physical attendance of Members has been dispensed with, there is no requirement for appointment of proxies. Accordingly, the facility for appointment of proxies by the members will not be available for the AGM and hence, the Proxy Form and Attendance Slip are not annexed to this Notice.

Institutional/Corporate Shareholders (i.e., other than individuals, HUF, NRI, etc.) intending to authorize their representatives to attend the AGM through VC/OAVM facility and/or vote through remote e-voting or e-voting at the AGM on its behalf are requested to send a scanned copy (PDF/JPG Format) of the relevant Board Resolution/ Authority letter, etc., with attested specimen signature of the duly authorized signatory(s) to the Scrutinizer by email at <u>dpvassociatesoffice@gmail.com</u> with a copy marked to the Company at <u>cs@indiamart.com</u>. They can also upload the said documents by clicking on "Upload Board Resolution/Authority Letter" displayed under "e-Voting" tab in their login.

- 4. The attendance of the Members attending the AGM through VC/OAVM facility shall be counted for the purpose of reckoning the quorum under Section 103 of the Act. In case of joint holders attending the meeting, the Member whose name appears as the first holder in the order of names as per the Register of Members / List of Beneficial owners of the Company will be entitled to vote at the AGM.
- 5. The recording of the AGM and transcript shall also be made available on the Company's website at <u>https://</u> <u>investor.indiamart.com/AGM_EGM.aspx</u> in the Investors

Relation Section, as soon as possible after the conclusion of the AGM.

- 6. - 8. Pursuant to Sections 101 and 136 of the Act read with relevant Rules made thereunder and in terms of Circulars, Company will send Annual Report along with notice of the AGM and other communications through electronic mode to those Members who have registered their e-mail address with the Depository Participants ('DPs') in case of shareholders holding shares in demat mode. Members who have not registered their email id's in their demat accounts are requested to update/register their e-mail address with their respective DPs.
- 9. In compliance with the aforesaid Circulars, the Notice of the AGM and Annual Report for FY 2023 along with login details for participating in the AGM through VC/OAVM facility including e-voting are being sent only through electronic mode to those members whose e-mail IDs are registered with the Company or RTA or DPs. - 10. The Notice of AGM and Annual Report for FY 2023 will be sent to those Members/ beneficial owners whose name will appear in the Register of Members/ list of beneficiaries received from the Depositories as on Friday, May 12, 2023.

- 11. The Securities and Exchange Board of India ('SEBI') has mandated the submission of Permanent Account Number ('PAN') by every participant in securities market. Members holding shares in electronic form are, therefore requested to submit their PAN to their DPs with whom they are maintaining their demat accounts.
- 12. SEBI vide Circular No. SEBI/HO/MIRSD/MIRSD RTAMB/P/ CIR/2022/8 dated January 25, 2022 mandated the listed companies to issue securities in dematerialized form only while processing service requests viz. Issue of duplicate securities certificate; claim from unclaimed suspense account; renewal/ exchange of securities certificate; endorsement; sub-division/splitting of securities certificate; consolidation of securities certificates/folios; transmission and transposition. Members can contact the Company or Company's RTA - Link Intime India Pvt. Ltd., for any assistance in this regard. Further, SEBI vide its circular dated March 16, 2023, provided clarifications on the norms/procedural requirements for processing service requests of investors.
- 13. Members are advised to make nomination in respect of their shareholding in the Company by submitting Form No. SH-13 to their respective DPs in case holding shares in demat mode in terms of Section 72 of the Act. The nomination form can be downloaded from the Company's website at <u>https://investor.indiamart.com/InvestorForms.</u> <u>aspx</u>. Members who require communication in physical form in addition to e-communication or have any other queries, may write to the RTA or Company at its Registered Office address.
- 14. SEBI has recently mandated furnishing of PAN, KYC details (i.e., postal address with pin code, email address, mobile number, bank account details) and nomination details by holders of securities. Effective from January 01, 2022, any service requests or complaints received from the member, will not be processed by RTA till the aforesaid details/ documents are provided to RTA. On or after April 01, 2023, in case any of the above cited documents/ details are not available in the folio(s), RTA shall be constrained to freeze such folio(s). Relevant details and forms prescribed by SEBI in this regard are available on the Company's website at <u>https://investor.indiamart.com/InvestorForms. aspx</u>.
- 15. Non-Resident Indian members are requested to inform RTA, immediately of:
 - a) Change in their residential status on return to India for permanent settlement;
 - b) Particulars of their bank account maintained in India with complete name, branch, account number, account type and address of the Bank with pin code number.

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- 16. The dividend, as recommended by the Board of Directors of the Company in its meeting held on April 28, 2023 (₹ 20/- per equity share of face value ₹ 10/- each for FY 2023), if declared subject to the approval of the shareholders at the meeting, will be paid/dispatched within 30 days from the date of AGM to those member(s) or their mandates:
 - a) whose names appear as Members / Beneficial Owners at the end of business hours on Thursday, May 11, 2023, in the Register of Members / list of Beneficial Owners furnished by National Securities Depository Limited and Central Depository Services (India) Limited in respect of the shares held in electronic form;
 - whose names appear as member(s) in the Register of Members of the Company on Thursday, May 11, 2023.

Pursuant to the provisions of Finance Act, 2020, dividend income is taxable in the hands of the members w.e.f. April 01, 2020 and the Company is required to deduct tax at source ('TDS') from dividend paid to the members at rates prescribed in the Finance Act, 2020 and the amendments thereof. In order to enable compliance with TDS requirements, members are requested to complete and/or update their Residential Status, PAN, Category as per the Finance Act, 2020 with their DPs.

For a Non-resident shareholder including Foreign Portfolio Investors, applicable withholding tax rate is either 20% (plus applicable surcharge and 4% cess) as per the Income Tax Act or the tax rate as specified in the tax treaty, subject to providing necessary documents i.e. no permanent establishment and beneficial ownership etc., declaration, tax residency Certificate, Form 10F, any other document which may be required to avail the tax treaty benefits by uploading the documents through Company's Portal at <u>https://indiamart.com/submissionoftaxdocuments</u>. The aforesaid declarations and documents need to be submitted by the shareholders through Company's Portal on or before Wednesday, June 07, 2023

In compliance with the provisions of Section 108 of the Act read and the rules framed thereunder, Regulation 44 of Listing Regulations, Secretarial Standard 2 issued by the Institute of Company Secretaries of India, as amended from time to time, and the Circulars as issued by Ministry of Corporate Affairs, the Company is pleased to provide remote e-Voting facility before the AGM and e-Voting facility at the AGM to its members to exercise their right to vote on all the resolutions proposed to be transacted at the AGM by electronic means. The facility of casting votes by a member using remote e-Voting and e-Voting at the AGM will be provided by National Securities Depository Limited ('NSDL').

The Members can opt for only one mode of voting i.e., remote e-Voting or e-Voting at the AGM. In case of voting by both the modes, vote cast through remote e-Voting will be considered final and e-Voting at the AGM will not be considered.

21. INSTRUCTIONS FOR E-VOTING AND JOINING THE AGM ARE AS FOLLOWS:

A. INSTRUCTIONS FOR REMOTE E-VOTING PRIOR TO THE AGM

i. The remote e-voting period will commence on Friday, June 09, 2023 (09:00 a.m. IST) and ends on Monday, June 12, 2023 (05:00 p.m. IST). During this period, members holding shares in dematerialized form as on the cut-off date i.e., Tuesday, June 06, 2023, may cast their vote electronically. A person, whose name appears in the Register of Members maintained by the Depositories as on the cut-off date, shall be entitled to avail the facility of remote e-voting.

The remote e-voting module shall be disabled by NSDL for voting thereafter. Once the vote on a resolution is cast by the member, the member shall not be allowed to change it subsequently.

- ii. The voting rights of Members shall be in proportion to their shares in the paid-up equity share capital of the Company as on the cut-off date. A person who is not a Member as on the cut-off date should treat this Notice for information purpose only.
- iii.
